

## ALTERNATIVE FORMAT MATERIALS FOR QUEBEC STUDENTS: HOW TO REGISTER AN EDUCATOR FOR LIBRARY SERVICES

Quebec educators who support students with perceptual disabilities can access alternate format materials made available from two non-profit organizations, the [Centre for Equitable Library Access \(CELA\)](#) and [BookShare](#).



**1.** Educators must register for a library card at the **BIBLIOTHÈQUE ET ARCHIVES NATIONALES DU QUÉBEC (BANQ)**. [Registration information](#) is provided at <http://www.banq.qc.ca/services/abonnement>. This library card (client number) is used to register with *CELA*.



**2. THE CENTRE FOR EQUITABLE LIBRARY ACCESS (CELA)** offers an [Educator Access Program](#) for teachers, librarians, educational assistants, special education teachers, and anyone who supports students with print disabilities in a formal educational setting. This program provides access to over 200,000 titles in both English and French, in audio, braille, e-text, and descriptive video formats. Educators must register using their BANQ account number and complete an online [form](#) (<https://educators.celalibrary.ca>).

**3. BOOKSHARE** is the world's largest accessible online library for people with print disabilities. Over 450,000 e-text and audio titles are available in English as well as other languages. An agreement between *BookShare* and *CELA* allows *CELA* members to benefit from *BookShare* services. Schools can [register](#) for an organizational account at <https://www.bookshare.org/signUpOrganization>. *Please note that centralized access via a **single school account** is recommended. Please contact your resource team or school librarian to verify if your school already has an account with BookShare.*
